**Bad Tatzmannsdorf** 

Arrive in **Rohrau** - see the birthplace of the world-famous composers Joseph and Michael Haydn, the **Haydn Museum**. Then continue to **Eisenstadt** - where Joseph Haydn lived for 30 years. Eisenstadt is the capital as well as the cultural and educational center of the province of Burgenland. This charming Baroque town - its buildings influenced by the Prince Esterhazy dynasty - is Austria's smallest and youngest provincial capital. Eisenstadt had its heyday in the 18th century when it was ruled by Prince Nikolaus Esterhazy.

See the **Esterhazy Palace** where Haydn conducted the court orchestra almost every evening, stop at **Raiding**, the birthplace of Franz Liszt and then, continue south to **Bad Tatzmannsdorf**
